The speed limit in all of Peaceful Valley is 20 MPH! Please obey the set speed for the safety of our neighborhood! A \$100 fine per occurrence will be issued in addition to County issued fines.

Dogs must be on leashes and/or confined to your yard. A \$100 fine will be issued if your dog is found running loose. Please help protect your pet and neighbors, by not allowing your dog to run loose. If you notice loose dogs, call and report it to the PVCC office at (360) 599-2761 or call animal control at (360) 733-2080.



Fireworks, no matter the occasion, are not permitted in residential areas of Peaceful Valley! Signs will be posted to remind residents that a \$100 fine per violation (up to \$600) will be issued for breaking this rule. Please utilize one of the Whatcom County designated firework areas or a public firework show. Landlords please remind your tenants, as you will be the one to receive the fine(s).

4th of July BBQ

As an alternative, Peaceful Valley will be hosting a BBQ potluck for Peaceful Valley residents at the clubhouse on the 4th of July. Residents will be allowed to set off LEGAL fireworks in a designated area on the clubhouse property, for this one day only if county and fire district restrictions allow. The BBQ will begin at 5:30PM and continue until dusk. Please come, meet your neighbors and see the recent work that's been done on the clubhouse.
